

**MANTON PARISH COUNCIL

Grants of exclusive rights of burial are recorded in The Register of Public Graves. The purchaser of the Grant receives the Certificate specifying the number/location of the relevant grave and the period of the grant and setting out the fees charges and regulations relating to the grant. The Certificate also includes a receipt for the purchase of the grant.

1. Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial

The Manton Parish Council ("the Council") in pursuance of its statutory powers and in consideration of the sum of £ (pounds) paid by *** ("the Grantee") to the Council now grants to the grantee the exclusive right of burial in the grave space marked ** in the consecrated/unconsecrated portion of the Council's cemetery at Manton ("the cemetery") for a period of ** years from the above date.

2. Fees charges and regulations

The grant of exclusive right of burial is made subject to the fees, charges, restrictions and regulations now in force or which may be made from time to time with regard to burials in and the management regulation or control of the cemetery by the Secretary of State, the Council or any other competent authority.
