



Minutes of
MANTON ANNUAL PARISH MEETING
Monday 9th May 2016

In attendance: 8 members of the public.

1. Welcome. Chair welcomed attendees to the meeting.
2. Apologies – none received
3. The minutes of last year's meeting were proposed as a true record and signed by Chair.
4. The Chairman outlined the achievements of the Parish Council and highlighted the requirement for the appointment of 2 new Councillors.

5. Public discussion time

A question relating to the source of funds received by Manton Parish Council outlined the Precept requirements and income related to the Burial Ground. It was noted that funding from RCC for maintenance and electricity will cease in 2016.

The wall surrounding the Burial ground will require maintenance in the future.

The recruitment of new Councillors is a priority with names of interested residents provided.

All planning applications for Manton will be updated weekly on the Manton Website. This may replace the email list but will have to be updated monthly manually because of limitations on the RCC planning portal but the links to all documents do work

RCC will be asked for a statement regarding the compulsory purchase of land required. Highways are also to be contacted regarding road and markings.
